We have targeted action to help you and your community remove intimidation and anti-social behaviour from your neighbourhood.

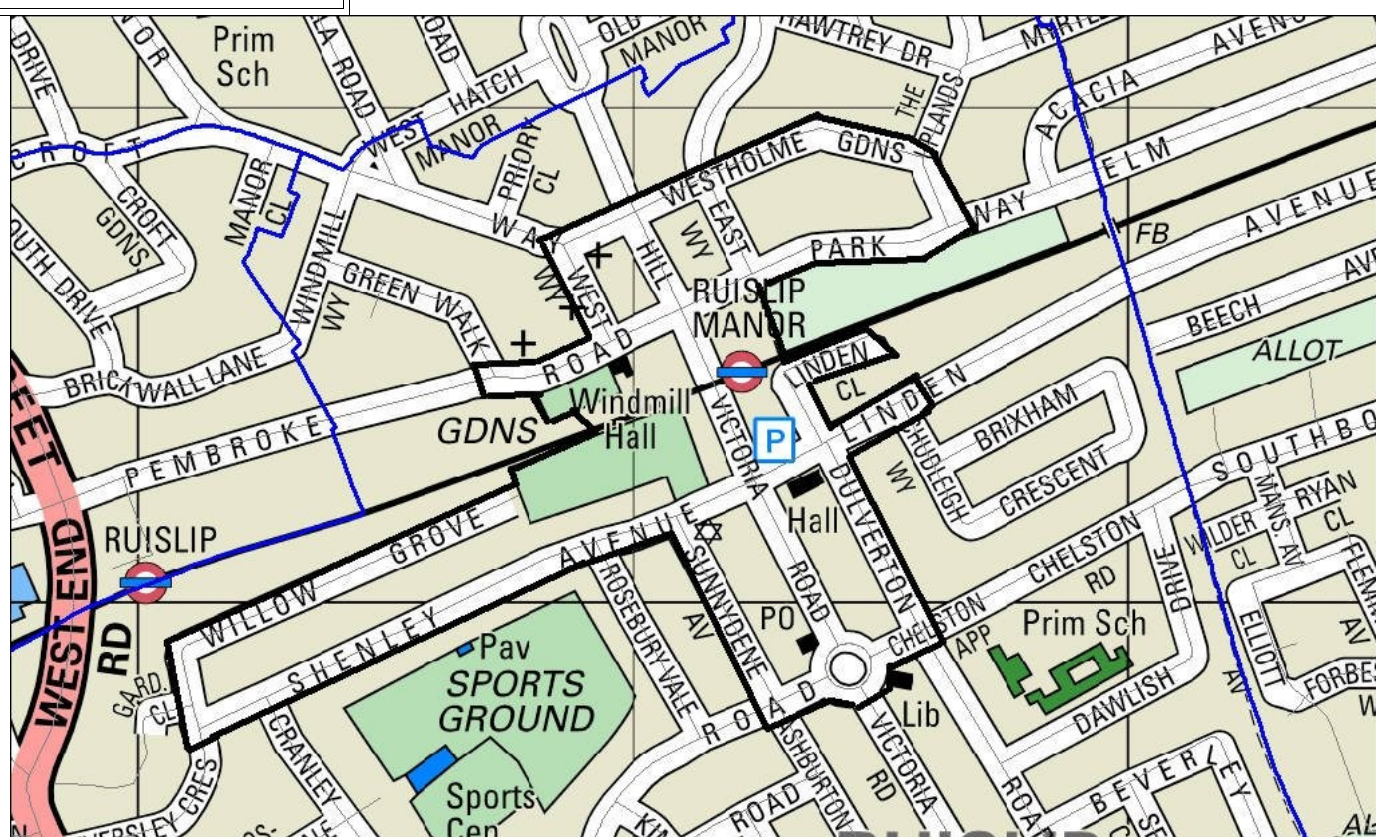

**What is a dispersal notice?**

In areas, above, police and community support officers have the power to disperse groups where their presence or behaviour has resulted, or is likely to result, in a member of the public being harassed, intimidated, alarmed or distressed. The individuals can then be excluded from a specific area for up to 24 hours.

Young people under the age of 16 found in the area after 9pm and who are not accompanied by a responsible adult **may** be taken home by a uniformed police officer if they are involved in, or at risk from, anti-social behaviour.

If individuals refuse to follow the direction to disperse they will be committing an offence that could result in a fine up to £2,500 or imprisonment.
